



10:1 - The Avis Driving Ratio or How To Find The Perfect Road Trip

It's a debate which has been going on since the invention of the wheel - what is the best and most beautiful driving road in the world? Avis took up the challenge to solve this mystery, once and for all. We enlisted the help of an international team of experts to determine the criteria needed to calculate the perfect driving road. Quantum physicist Dr Mark Hadley from the University of Warwick, legendary Formula 1 race track designer Hermann Tilke and renowned roller coaster designer John Wardley combined their expertise and discussed these essential questions: What makes a road unique? How can driving pleasure be measured? The results show that the key phases of a drive - bends, straights and acceleration - need to strike just the right balance. This means drivers can experience the exhilaration of speed and acceleration, whilst long stretches allow them to enjoy the scenery and corners test their driving capabilities. To be able to compare and rank different driving roads, our experts created the Avis Driving Ratio (ADR) which is designed to calculate the correlation between these phases and show the result as a mathematical value. Precise calculations and exhaustive on-road tests in a Porsche 911 Carrera, a Jaguar XKRS and a Mercedes-Benz E350 from

the Avis fleet showed that a road with an ADR of 10:1 offers the most balanced driving experience. The first value increases on roads with very long straights and decreases on routes with lots of bends.

Black Forest



Follow the B500 and B317 past idyllic lake Titisee and thick forests, as the road heads up to the Feldberg, the highest mountain in Germany's Black Forest. On your way to Todtnau you can enjoy spectacular views over wooded hillsides. The route then passes into a stretch

of road along the L126 and L124 that will keep drivers on their toes with its twists and turns, allowing them to experience a most enjoyable drive. From an altitude of 1,137 metres you will head down to Bad Krozingen at 232 metres where you can already breathe French savoir-vivre.

Orossglockner High Alpine Road



Make sure your seatbelt is securely fastened when embarking on your journey along the Grossglockner High Alpine Road - you may find yourself dreaming of a wild chase with Goldfinger's henchmen. At any rate, this route is indeed breathtaking. More than a dozen hairpin

bends will challenge your driving capabilities and lead up to an altitude of 2,500 metres. Far above the treeline, the demanding mountain drive will be rewarded with a panorama of the eastern flank of the Grossglockner, the highest mountain in Austria with an altitude of 3,798 metres.
