# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Dear marathon runner. in the following you will find important information about the schedule of this year's Mainova Frankfurt Marathon. Please take enough time to read this information carefully.

#### **COMPETITION RULES**

The Mainova Frankfurt Marathon is governed by the International Rules of Competition (IWR) of the World Athletics and German Athletics Association.

#### **MARATHON CENTER TRADE FAIR**

Ludwig-Erhard-Anlage 1 60327 Frankfurt

The entrances and halls are connected by a pathway system (Via Mobile).

### **DIRECTION**

Please travel, if possible, by public transportation as there will be increased traffic in the city during the marathon weekend.

Your start pass/ start number is valid as a RMV ticket on the day of the event.

- October 24th & 25th: all parking garages in the area around of the fair (Rebstockparkhaus Fr+Sa closed)
- October 24th & 25th: Skyline Plaza parking garage, entrance Brüsseler Straße, 1st hour free of charge
- October 26th: Rebstock parking garage, 60486 Frankfurt am Main, with shuttle service to the exhibition grounds
- Vehicles higher than 2m: Rebstock area, Block D (without infrastructure)

Trade Fair (Messe Frankfurt), hall 1, level 2 (→ floor plan)

The blue line on the floor will guide you to the race number pickup area.

#### **IMPORTANT**

- please bring: your race passport (or name your bib number and identify yourself with your ID card)
- if you want someone else to pick up your race number: race passport or declaration of consent with additional copy of identity card of the participant
- the starter bag also works as a clothes bag for the clothes collection on Sunday

## YOU RECEIVE...

- Your personal race number with integrated timing transponder and safety pins for attachment
- a sticker with your race number for the baggage disposal
- Your starter bag with information and samples from our sponsors

Other booked additional services can be picked up until Sunday, October 26th 2025. 10am at the marathonmall! You will find the corresponding coupons on your bib number.

#### **RACE NUMBER...**

- authorizes to participate in the Mainova Frankfurt Marathon 2025
- is not transferable and must be worn visibly on the chest
- is not allowed to be changed, especially not the lettering
- no start number = no ranking
- is valid as a ticket for the RMV area on race day



# **26.10.2025 BEFORE START**

# BAGGAGE (CLOTHES) DISPOSAL (→ Plan start and finish area)

- can be done before the start from 8am in hall 1, level 1. For this purpose, please stick the sticker with your start number into the marked field on the clothes bag
- accepts only starter bags of the Mainova Frankfurt Marathon 2025
- other bags can be handed in for a fee of 4€ at the checkroom in hall 1, level 1
- closes after the race at 5pm
- there is no possibility to drop off baggage outside of hall 1.1

#### **TIMING**

- via a timing transponder on the race number
- Please make sure that the transponder on the start number is not bent. Otherwise timekeeping will not be possible.
- For the video checks, wear your race number clearly and permanently visible on your chest

#### **PERSONAL NUTRITION**

- Can be handed in at the Info-Point in the hallway (Via Mobile) in front of Hall 1, Level 2. (Friday: 12 noon to 7 p.m., Saturday: 10 a.m. to 7 p.m., Sunday: 7 a.m. to 8 a.m.)
- for ambitious runners: men under 2:45:00; women under 3:00:00 (bring your starting pass as proof)
- for participants who require special nutrition for medical reasons (medical certificate required)
- Self-nutrition can be provided at the following kilometers: KM 5 (right), 10 (right), 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40



# **PACE MAKER**

- Support over the entire marathon distance by experienced runners with the following finish times: 2:59, 3:14, 3:29, 3:44, 3:59, 4:14, 4:29, 4:44, 4:59 and 5:29 hours
- They are marked by flags with the corresponding finish times

# 26.10.2025 THE START (→ Plan start and finish area)

#### THINGS YOU MUST TAKE WITH YOU:

- your personal start number -> clearly visible on the chest
- possibly a sponge -> included in the starter bag At the aid stations are tubs with water for dipping the sponges



#### LINE UP AT THE START



Friedrich-Ebert-Anlage, towards city center



- Entrance to the starting area is only possible with an official start number
- The allocation to starting blocks 1-6 is based on your specified finish time. The starting block can be recognized by the corresponding logo on the left edge of your race number
- important: please place yourself within the starting blocks according to your target time
- due to the evaluation of the net time by means of the timing mats there will be no disadvantage for anyone
- the start process will be completed in four waves starting at 10 a.m.
- You must start the Mainova Frankfurt Marathon by 10:30 a.m.

Get to the start as early as possible. Unnecessary hecticness and nervousness only hinder you in the achievement of your personal performance.



Note: Clothing left behind in the starting area is considered abandoned property (§ 959 BGB) and will not be stored. It will be disposed of or donated.

# 26.10.2025 ON THE TRACK

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES**

- Race number ribbon (except for relay races), bicycles, or other escorts on the course are prohibited.
- Headphones are prohibited for participation in championships, but are allowed for amateurs
- Baby joggers must start in the last starting block
- Animals are not permitted on the running track and will result in disqualification (exceptions for trained assistance animals are possible by prior arrangement).

#### **WATER STATIONS**

- the refreshment points are located on the right or left side, at km 5 and 10 they are on both sides
- medical assistance: available at the refreshment points
- toilets: at km 5, 10 and every 2,5 km thereafter

# 26.10.2025 **FINISH AREA**

→ Plan start and finish area

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

- the finish is in the Festhalle, on the grounds of the Trade Fair (Messe Frankfurt)
- free entrance for spectators
- please leave the finish area quickly to avoid traffic jams
- finish time: 5pm

#### YOU RECEIVE:

- vour medal
- a poncho
- refreshments → overview water stations at the finish area

### **BAGGAGE (CLOTHES) DISPOSAL, SHOWERS, MASSAGE**

- Collection of the bag: until 5pm in hall 1, level 1 against presentation of your race number
- Changing rooms and showers: hall 1, level 0
- Massage service: from 12 noon to 5pm in hall 1, level 1 (use only under the condition that you are freshly showered)

# **ADDITIONAL SERVICES**

#### T-SHIRT AND LONGSLEEVE COLLECTION

- You can pick up your booked participant shirt at the marathon-mall in hall 1, level 2 until Sunday, October 26, 2025, 10:00 a.m.. You will find a corresponding voucher tear-off on your race number. If you have not yet booked a shirt you can do this online until October 19, 2025 via your Dashboard under "Change registration". Or on site at the HOKA booth.
- -> Please pick up your shirt in time. After 10 am the shirts will go go on free sale

#### **T-SHIRT PRINT**

 You can get your booked flex print printed on a T-shirt of your choice at the marathonmall in hall 1, level 2. If you have not yet booked a T-shirt print, you can do so until October 19, 2025 via your dashboard under "Change registration". Alternatively, the T-shirt print can be purchased on site for an additional €2.

#### **MEDAL ENGRAVING**

- You can get your medal engraving at the marathonmall in hall 1, level 2 from 12 noon in the area of the bib number pick up. If you have not yet booked the medal engraving you can book this until October 19, 2025 via your dashboard under "Change registration". Alternatively, you can have the medal engraved for €10 in cash on site.

#### **BIB NUMBER MAGNETS**

You will receive your booked bib number magnets at the bib number pick-up together with your race documents.

#### **CHARITY-WISHLET**

You can pick up your Wishlet at the ASB stand at the marathon-mall in Hall 1, Level 2. If you have not yet booked a Wishlet you can do this until October 19, 2025 via your dashboard under "Change deregistration". Alternatively, you can purchase a Wishlet on site at the ASB- or HOKA booth.

#### **RACE PACE BRACELET**

- At the marathonmall you can pick up your personal Race Pace bracelet at the T. Rowe Price booth! With different target times from 3:30h to 5:00h you will find exactly the right support for your marathon. Whether you are an experienced runner or a newcomer, the Race Pace Bracelet from T. Rowe Price helps you to keep an eye on your pace and achieve your goals!

#### **AWARDS FOR AGE CLASSES AND TEAMS**

- the three first place winners in each age group (IWR regulation):
   Dispatch of a free start and one incl. participant shirt from HOKA for the Mainova Frankfurt Marathon 2026, dispatch by mail probably end of January 2026
- there will be no award ceremony for the age groups on the day of the event

#### **MEETING POINTS**

- You can meet your friends and family members who do not have access to the closed-off areas, at the following two meeting points: hall 1, level 2, or "P1" (area on the fairgrounds between Festhalle and hall 1)
  - → Plan start and finish area
- A-Z orientation signs are posted around P1, which can be used as meeting points. For example, the first letter of your name or your club team's name would be a good meeting point.

# **ASB CHARITY-PROJEKT "WÜNSCHEWAGEN"**

The large donation gate is traditionally located at the Hauptwache. At kilometers 7.5 and 39, participants can pass through the donation gate and thus make a donation of 4 euros per pass to the Rhine-Main Wish Car. Anyone who has passed through the donation gate once or twice will be contacted again after the event and will have the opportunity to opt out of the donation. With the project "Wünschewagen – dare to make your last wishes come true," ASB supports seriously ill people. The Wünschewagen takes the passenger and an accompanying person to their dream destination – including shared beautiful memories.



### 8 TIPS FOR WASTE PREVENTION



- 1. Use your race number as ticket for a free public transport to come to the Mainova Frankfurt Marathon!
- 2. Wear old clothes- no plastic foil- for your warmup and throw your clothes in the boxes for the collection of old clothes!
- 3. Use your goodie Bag as your bag for the whole day. It is perfect for transport your clothes or shoes but also for shopping or bringing returnable bottles back!
- 4. Throw your waste in litter bins!
- Bring your registration information online as a PDF file on your phone with you!
- 6. Bring your own cutlery and dishes to the pasta party!
- 7. Use your own shopping bag on the marathon mall!
- 8. Turn off the water during using soap or wash lotion!

Waste from participants on the exhibition grounds is collected centrally and recycled professionally by a specialist waste disposal company.
